**Director of Music Ministries (Part-time)**

Saint Andrews United Methodist Church, located in Garner, North Carolina, seeks an experienced, energetic, detail-oriented, multitasking individual to oversee and direct the entire music ministry of the church. The qualified individual will serve the dual role of pianist for Sunday morning worship hour as well as director for the adult choir. The position will be part time and will require around 15 hours per week.

Responsibilities include

- Play for choir rehearsals and worship services to include preludes, offertories, anthems, communion music and postludes, etc.
- Conduct weekly evening rehearsals for adult choir
- Lead all rehearsals and performances throughout the year including “specials” and seasonal events
- Recruit members for the choir
- Maintain the music library and the music budget insuring that the selections available are both traditional and timely
- Oversee the care of and maintenance of worship service instruments
- Plan worship music and participate in worship planning team meetings
- Work closely with Children’s Ministry and Youth Ministry directors to include those groups when possible in Sunday worship and “specials”
- Attend all staff meetings
- If unavailable for regular services, help provide a qualified substitute
- Presence at all Sunday worship services and “specials” is required (paid time off is provided)

Qualifications

- Love for and knowledge of traditional and contemporary music and its role in worship
- Be of good moral character and willing to work with the entire church organization
- Be able to perform at a high musical level
- Knowledge of audio-visual equipment necessary for in-person and virtual services
- A bachelor’s degree in music with emphasis on piano or equivalent experience
- Two+ years experience in church music leadership
