Large print hymnals are available for your convenience.

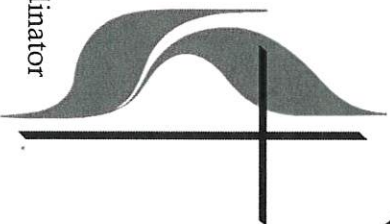
