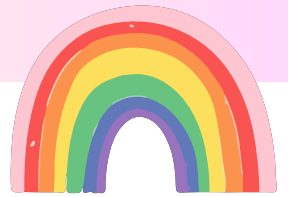

CHAPEL

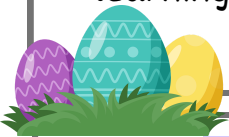
Before we left for Spring Break, Pastor Beth visited us to tell us the story of Jesus and how we can always remember to love one another and show kindness every day.
